### Event Update (1)

#### Arrival

It's going to be a busy weekend at Draycote. Alongside our 34 boats racing this weekend there is also a Feva and Optimist training group taking place. Marshalls will be around to help guide you to where you need to go with your boats upon arrival.

For all competitors please note the following:

- Dogs are not allowed onsite, but may be walked in the adjacent country park
- Vehicles must only be parked where instructed, usually the car parks. Under no circumstances shall vehicles be on the slipway, foreshore or grass areas, Cars may only be parked in the designated car parks: either the club's lower car park (free) or the Seven Trent pay & display car parks.
- The Clubhouse will be open from 08:30 each day
- Food: the club have confirmed that they will ensure that the cafe is available (for a short time) for food after sailing (approx 4.00 pm).
- The bar will be open from 1200 to at least 1800 each day.
- If you are traveling to the club on Friday night and require access, please be aware that the site may be locked after 19:00. Please contact the club beforehand if you might require access after this time.
- There is no camping on site, but campervans may be parked (for a fee) provided that they are parked in the lower club car park at the far end. Please ensure you contact the club.
