Overview of Venue

Felixstowe Ferry Sailing Club is located outside the main town of Felistowe. Please refer to the pictures to ensure that when you book accommodation you factor in any travel time to your plans.

Accommodation

Felixstowe has plenty of holiday lets, B&B's and hotels. As mentioned above please do not book anywhere near Bawdsey or Harwich, some websites

are misleading and show these locations as being very near, but there are rivers between the club and them.

Camping and Camper pitches will be available at the club; more details of how to book and pay for this will be sent out at a later date but prices will be:

- 2 man tent = £7.50 per night
- Family tent = £10 per night
- Campers (hard standing first come first served) = £12 per night
 Campers (not guaranteed hard standing) = £10 per night

Local Information


Cafes

There numerous cafes; the club has recommended Winkles (opens and 9.30 am) and The Ferry Cafe (opens at 10.00 am). Both shut around 4.00pm.

There is a Community Hospital in Felixstowe but it doesn't have an A&E department - they can do minor injuries and it isn't open 24hrs. The nearest A&E is in Ipswich which is 15 miles from Felixstowe.
