## 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> April 2021

### Arrival

The code for Gate Four has been emailed to all competitors. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day.

**To assist with the NHS Test and Trace system please would everyone coming onto site scan the QR code which is available at all entrances.**

### Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

You have been allocated **Zones 3 & 4** for your dinghies. You have been allocated **one space per boat**. Please ensure you put your boats in the correct zones.

### Road Trailers

Put road trailers in **Zone 5**, unless you keep the boat on the road base overnight, when it can be put in your space in Zones 3 & 4.

### Face Masks/Coverings

WPNSA recommends that face coverings are worn outside when interacting with others in groups of 6, 2 households or any training groups.

### Parking

**All vehicles** are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.

### Reception

### Lockers & Changing Rooms

Lockers and changing rooms are not available at present.

### Cafeteria

A cafeteria service will be available from the hatch on the main balcony. It will be open 08:00 – 17:00 at the weekend.

## Water Refill Points

WPNSA encourages visitors to bring their own reusable drinking containers. There are four water bottle refill points: one by Zone 5, one outside the toilet corridor and two at the bottom of the Event Hall ramp. You will see these signs next to the refill points:
