Arrival and Joining Instructions

Itchenor Sailing club 23-27th October

Itchenor sailing Club hopes that you enjoy your time with us and we will do all we can to make your event exciting. Part of that is to ensure that all those attending take care of fellow competitors, supporters and the organising team.

Remember Covid 19 is still present and a real and present risk.

- Please dispose of all rubbish directly in a bin.
- Follow the directions of the Race team, ISC staff, Marshalls and the Beachmaster they are there to help you
- Follow any guidance notices displayed on ISC property
- Competitors, parents and support persons are encouraged to engage in Lateral Flow Testing to support all sailors, staff visitors and parents in staying Covid Free.

REMEMBER - HANDS-FACE-SPACE

Arrival, Parking and Berthing,

ISC is located at Itchenor Sailing Club, The Lane, West Itchenor, Chichester, PO20 7AG. Upon arrival, you are requested to turn left opposite the club into the public car park.

Trailers must be manhandled from the road to the Club stage as vehicles are not permitted down the Club Lane. Parking for cars is available at the Harbour Conservancy car park (Pay & Display).

Boats shall be kept on their trailers to save space in their assigned area on the ISC landing stage.

Please note that the staging could get wet at high water so all gear and valuables should be left secure

Boats staying on the stage overnight should be tied down.

Clubhouse and grounds.

All competitors are invited to use the facilities of the Club during their stay. Competitors will be deemed to be temporary members for the duration of the event, and as such, shall abide by all the Club's rules and traditions.

It is recommended that valuables are not left in the changing rooms. Items of value may be deposited with the Office for safe keeping, at owner's risk.

Dress

Members and visitors to the Club are asked to change from their sailing clothes in the evenings and dress appropriately for the time of day.

Accomodation

Accommodation in the Club may be available. Please book with the Office. 01243-512400

Catering

Breakfast, lunch and evening meals will be available at the club each day.

Warm food will be available to sailors coming off the water, throughout the event please discuss with ISC reception to pre order for each day as required.

Attention is drawn to NOR 14 Support Person Vessels. Competitors are not permitted to place food, drink or clothing on official support boats due to the risk of Covid transmission.

Ribs

There are no facilities at ISC to launch RIBs. If you wish to bring a Support Boat please launch from the Harbour Conservancy Public Launch Site (around 150m West of ISC) www.conservancy.co.uk RIBs up to 6m in length may be left on the small pontoon at ISC with an overnight charge of £10.
