### BustinSkin Coastal Marathon

The annual BustinSkin Coastal Marathon will be running from WPNSA on Sunday. Gate Four will not be in use until the event is finished, which should be early afternoon. Gate Six will be open for access and departure whilst Gate Four is not in use.

### Arrival

**The code for Gate Four will be 8774.** The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day. The code for pedestrian gate next to gate 4 is C1739.

A one-way system will be in operation to drop off dinghies. Access the site through Gate Four, drop off your dinghy and launching trolley, put the road trailer in marked area in the Boat Yard, then drive out through Gate Six to park the vehicle in the main gravel car park over the road opposite Reception. Vehicles will not be permitted in the dinghy park.

#### 420 Road Trailers

**Please put road trailers by the yachts in the boat yard, where indicated.**

#### RIB Road Trailers

Please put RIB road trailers at the back of the gravel car park, behind the RIB compound. You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your trailer.

## Parking

**All vehicles** are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Please keep the small car park free for windsurf users to access their slipway. Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.

## Reception

## Lockers

Lockers are available. You will require a £1 coin for use.

## Cafeteria

The Cafeteria is open 08:00 – 17:30 during the event.

## Water Refill Points

WPNSA encourages visitors to bring their own reusable drinking containers. There are four water bottle refill points: one in the Cafeteria, one outside the toilet corridor and two at the bottom of the Event Hall ramp. You will see these signs next to the refill points:



## Dinghy Park – No Glass or Crockery

For everyone's safety, we kindly ask that no glass or crockery is used in the dinghy park or under the balcony. Many sailors are bare footed or just in dinghy boots walking around, so we want to prevent any cuts from broken glass or crockery.

## Scooters, Skateboards, Segways etc.

We kindly ask that these are not used on site and especially not inside the building. They cause quite a few accidents, not least by the people riding them!

## Use of Drones
